Welcome to i-Learn

The YMCA i-Learn program in partnership with the Chandler Unified School District offers self-paced computerized classes at our YMCA facilities. We offer two sessions per day—7:30am to 11:30am and 12:00pm to 3:45 pm. The i-Learn program offers students a flexible way to complete classes and earn your high school diploma.

To enroll and participate in i-Learn, students must be a self-motivated student and have the ability to work independently. Every student works at their own pace on their remaining coursework. Students may enroll at any time during the year, provided available space. Chandler Unified School District approval is required to enroll.

For only a \$25 registration fee per semester, students who are aged 21 and under and not enrolled in school can earn their high school diploma. In addition, i-Learn may be offered during the summer for those students who need to make up classes. Existing full-time i-Learn students may also attend during the summer to earn to continue their studies.



Here's how it works:

- Fill out the attached form and turn it in to the YMCA. You may also call (602) 212-6110 or log onto www.valleyymca.org for more information
- Students referred from a CUSD school need to bring a copy of their transcript and an district approved



counselor referral.

- You will reserve time in the YMCA computer lab by selecting from available time slots. Students are required to attend a minimum of 20 hours if they are not attending another school.

- i-Learn staff will review a student handbook that students must sign and agree to participate.
 - Full-time students must pay a non-refundable \$25 registration fee prior to the start of classes
 - Students will be given a complimentary YMCA membership. The membership is a privilege, not a right and we reserve the right to revoke student memberships at any time.
- Upon completion of all curriculum requirements, your grades will be reported to your home school.
